

**MINUTES OF THE SPECIAL CALLED
SELMA CITY COUNCIL MEETING
HELD ON THURSDAY, FEBRUARY 5, 2004**

The Selma City Council met in a special called session in the Council Chambers of City Hall on Thursday, February 5, 2004 at 5:00 p.m. with the following members present: President George Evans and Council members Rita S. Franklin, Glen Sexton, Jean T. Martin, Nancy G. Sewell and Benny L. Tucker. Others present were City Clerk Lois Williams, City Treasurer Cynthia Mitchell, Mayor James Perkins, Jr., Mayor's Administrative Assistant Sherri James and City Attorney Jimmy Nunn. Councilwoman Crenshaw arrived during executive session. Councilman Randolph arrived at the meeting at 5:19 p.m. Reverend Morton gave the invocation.

After roll call, President Evans declared a quorum present and the meeting was opened for the transactions of business as set forth on the agenda.

I. TO ACCEPT THE LETTER OF RETIREMENT FROM ASSISTANT POLICE CHIEF ROBERT JACOBS ADDRESSED TO COUNCIL PRESIDENT GEORGE P. EVANS

President Evans stated the purpose of this special called meeting is to discuss the acceptance of the letter of retirement from Police Chief Robert Jacobs. President Evans stated this meeting was called by Council members Glenn Sexton, Rita Franklin and Benny Tucker.

A motion was made by Councilwoman Sewell and seconded by Councilwoman Franklin to recess this meeting into executive session to discuss good name and character regarding the acceptance of the retirement letter from Assistant Chief Jacobs. A roll call vote was taken and the motion failed. There were four affirmative votes and five negative votes. President Evans, Councilwoman Martin, Councilman Randolph, Councilman Tucker, and Councilwoman Crenshaw cast negative votes.

President Evans stated there would be no reason to continue this meeting based on the acceptance of an extension letter submitted by Assistant Chief Jacobs, as per Mayor Perkins.

There being no other business to come before the Council, on motion made by Councilwoman Sewell and seconded by Councilwoman Crenshaw, the Council voted by unanimous consent to adjourn this meeting at 6:08 p.m.




