Selma Riverfront Multi-Use Historic Riverfront Walking and Bicycle Trail

AWARD OF CONTRACT FOR
CONSTRUCTION, ENGINEERING, INSPECTION SERVICES

WHEREAS, the City of Selma, Alabama (*the "City"*) is the recipient of a FY 2008 Transportation Enhancement Grant, Project Number STPTE-TE08(934) from the Alabama Department of Transportation which requires Construction, Engineering, Inspection services by a reputable firm that is QCI qualified, for monitoring of erosion control, traffic control, and concrete; *and*

WHEREAS, the City solicited proposals from qualified firms and individuals interested in providing Construction, Engineering, Inspection services for the **Selma Riverfront Multi-Use Historic Riverfront Walking and Bicycle Trail Project** via Request for Proposals; *and*

WHEREAS, the City received proposals from 2 (two) qualified companies and the City Council approved the Mayor's recommendation to select the proposal submitted by Goodwyn, Mills and Cawood based on their qualifications to inspect the project; *and*

WHEREAS, the cost for the professional services will be incurred via the Community Reinvestment Account.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Selma, Alabama that:

George Evans, in his capacity as Mayor, is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with Goodwyn, Mills and Cawood to perform Construction, Engineering, Inspection services for the **Selma Riverfront Multi-Use Historic Riverfront Walking and Bicycle Trail Project** as set forth in its proposal.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that said contract expenses shall be encumbered via the Community Reinvestment Account.
