Release of Duty Badge and Weapon

WHEREAS, Officer Willie Felder has retired from the Selma Police Department after diligently serving as an officer for twenty (20) years and desires to retain his duty badge and weapon as apart of his retirement benefits; *and*



Officer Willie Felder has retired in good standing from the Selma Police Department after diligently serving as an officer of the department for twenty (20) years *and* has satisfied the requirements necessary to retain his duty badge and weapon.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the duty badge and weapon of Officer Willie Felder is hereby released to him as apart of his retirement benefits.
