Authorization to submit application

SELMA DIGITAL OPPORTUNITY AMERICORPS PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the City of Selma, Alabama (*the "City"*) desires to apply to The Corporation for National & Community Service for a FY 2012-2013 competitive grant for the City of Selma Digital Divide Program which addresses computer literacy, citywide training and community educational initiatives; *and*

WHEREAS, the City of Selma possesses the legal authority to apply for said grant and execute the proposed program; *and*

WHEREAS, the application will be reviewed and grants awarded to localities rating the highest in the rating criteria; *and*

WHEREAS, the total cost of the project is \$475,443.00 and the maximum grant amount is \$264,653.00; the City of Selma pledges to provide approximately \$135,000.00 in cash match and in-kind match in the amount of approximately \$73,213.00 to be appropriated in the FY 2012-2013 grant match budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Selma, Alabama that:

The City hereby authorizes the filing of said application, including all understandings and assurances contained therein, and does hereby authorize and direct Mayor George Evans as the official representative of the applicant to act in connection with the application and to provide such information as may be required.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the expenses of the agreement will be incurred via the grant match line item.




