

**RESOLUTION  
R 233 - 07 / 08**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Selma, desires to apply for a Federal Boating Infrastructure Grant to pay 75% of the cost of constructing a boat dock on the north shore of the Alabama River, which shall be located a few yards upstream from the Edmund Pettus Bridge; *and*

**WHEREAS**, the funding request shall include a floating dock with standard equipment for visiting boats in excess of 26 feet, and a ramp sufficient to allow for the rise and fall of the river; *and*

**WHEREAS**, The City of Selma authorizes the Alabama Department of Environmental Management to apply for and administer said grant; *and*

**WHEREAS**, the City confirms that the activities sought on the application will be on public lands owned by the City; *and*

**WHEREAS**, the City of Selma agrees that it will provide ordinary and routine operations and maintenance of the facility for no less than a minimum of the 20 year term of the agreement; *and*

**WHEREAS**, the City of Selma will provide 25% cash match via the grant match line item to be placed in the 2008/2009 budget; *and*

**WHEREAS**, the City of Selma has the capacity to complete said project within the construction period allowed by the United States Fish and Wild Life Services.

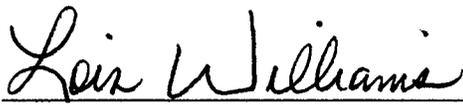
**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Selma City Council hereby authorize the Alabama Department of Environment Management to submit a grant application in behalf of the City of Selma to cover 75% (approximately \$600,000.00) of the cost of constructing a boat dock on the north shore of the Alabama River, located upstream from the Edmund Pettus Bridge. The City Council further agrees to provide a 25% cash match (approximately \$150,000.00) to be included in the grant match line item for the 2008-2009 fiscal year budget.

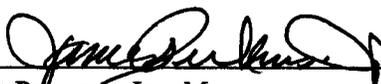
